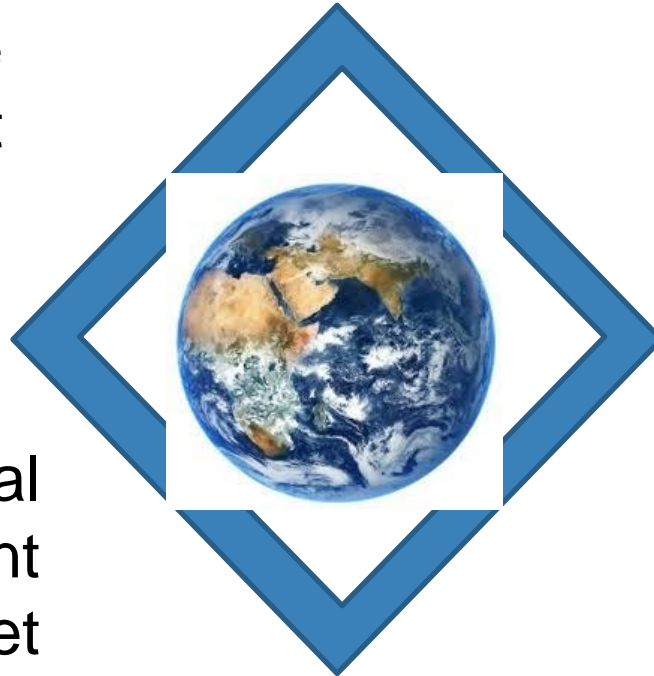

Procurers (and bidders!) need better tools to quantify and evaluate these sustainability aspects

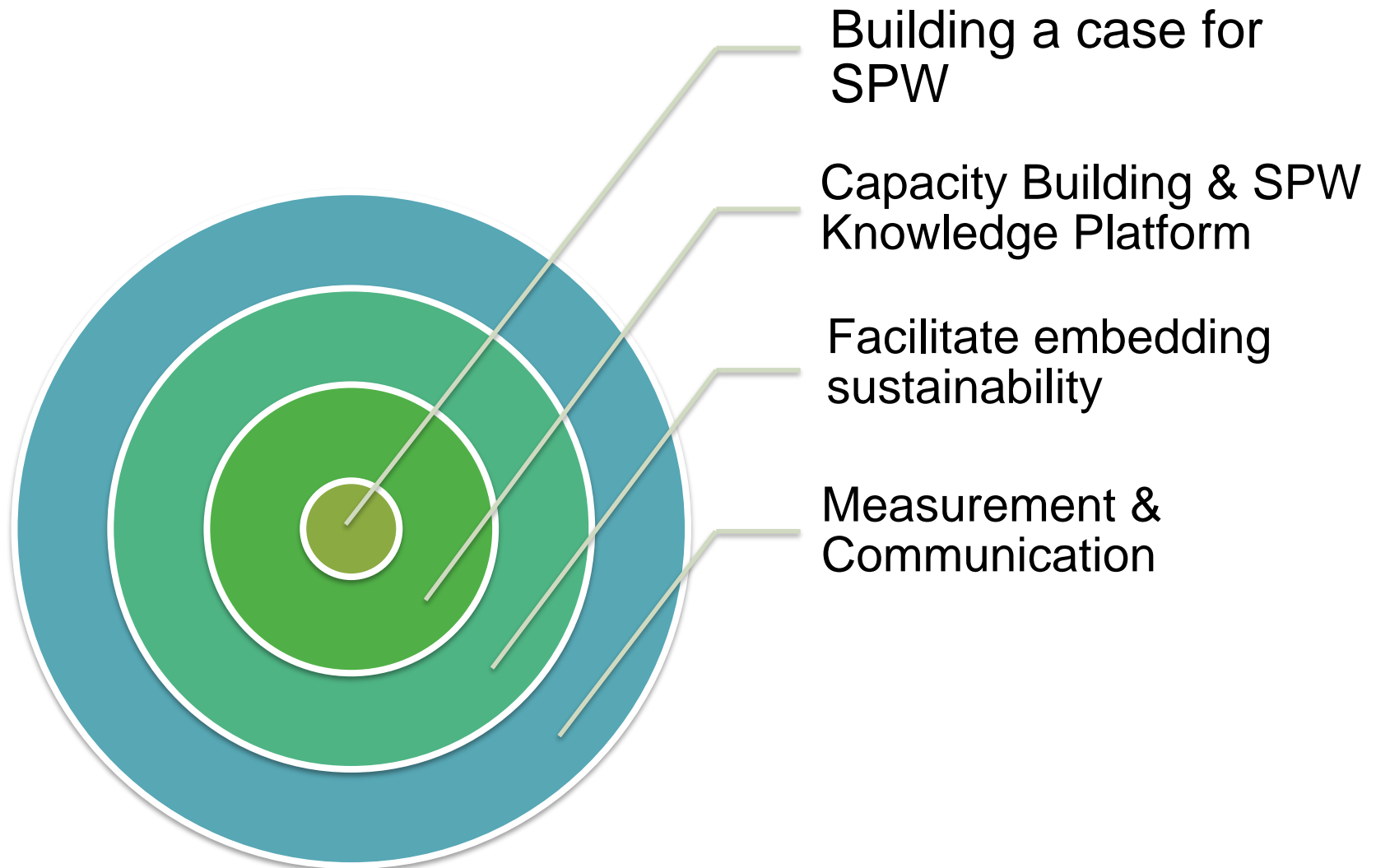


Lack of financial resources in low and developing countries

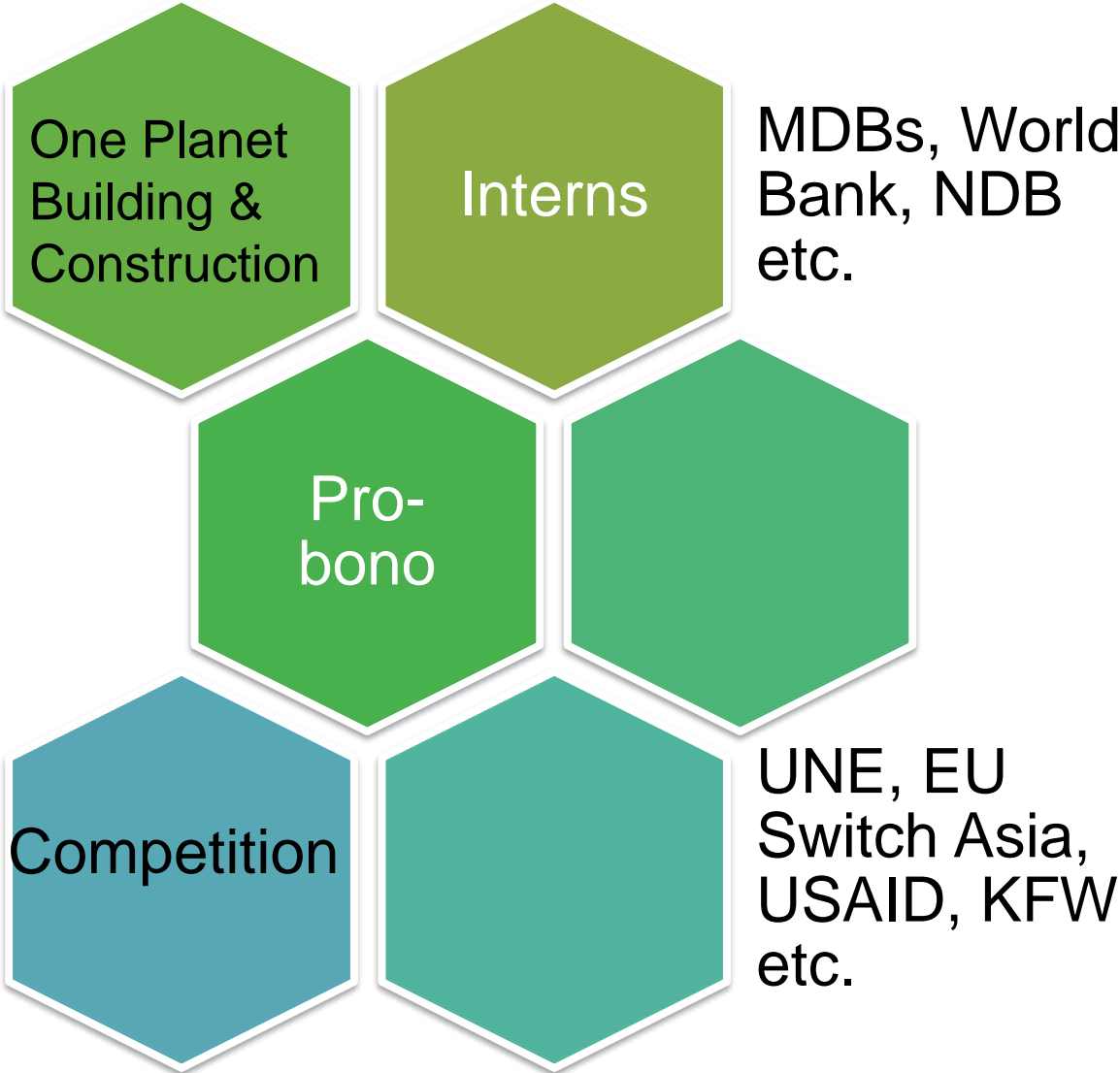
