To be reported

- **Macro-policies** with SCP objectives
 - Macro-policies specifically focused on SCP
 - Macro-policies with SCP as a key priority / objective
(e.g. policies on sustainable development, green economy/growth, circular economy, development, poverty reduction)
 - Sectoral macro-policies with SCP objectives
- **Policy instruments** contributing to the shift to SCP
 - Regulatory / legal instruments
